

Proportional Giving Chart

Stewardship is a lifelong journey, and a decision to tithe can be joyful part of that journey. Here is a suggestion for getting started:

- 1. Find the current percent of income that you are giving to the church:
 - Find your approximate annual income and move across the row to find your current annual giving amount.
 - The number at the top of that column is your current percent of giving.

 Of course, you could just use a calculator to divide your annual giving by your annual income and move the decimal point two places to the right.
